ROUND ROCK ARTS FEST (AUGUST)

The Round Rock Arts Fest is an annual celebration of creativity in all of its forms, with live performances, food and drink, vendors of all kinds, visual artists, interactive art and music experiences, and more! This three day event is for families, residents, and visitors to Round Rock, and admission is free! Round Rock Arts Fest is hosted by the City of Round Rock Arts and Culture.



DÍA DE LOS MUERTOS PROCESSION AND FESTIVAL (NOVEMBER)

Hosted by Round Rock Ballet Folklorico, Williamson County Hispanic Heritage Committee, the City of Round Rock and Round Rock Arts, the Día de los Muertos Festival is an annual celebration of the traditional Mesoamerica holiday honoring both death and the cycle of life. The popular event features a festive parade, kids activities, food vendors and more.



POP UP ARTS MARKET (YEAR-ROUND)

Hosted by the Round Rock Arts and Culture department at Main Street Plaza, the seasonal pop-up art shows feature art, ceramics, jewelry, and more — all created by local artisans. Shop, explore and interact with Round Rock's thriving creative community.



ROUND ROCK MARKET DAYS (YEAR-ROUND)

Explore local vendors, artists and makers the first Saturday of each month at Round Rock Market Days. The free event takes place in Downtown Round Rock and highlights the area's small businesses, artisans, musicians and food trucks. ROUND ROCK PUBLIC ART
